Physical Examinations for Positions Requiring Commercial Driver's License

I. PURPOSE

To set forth the procedures concerning a preemployment medical examination for all applicants considered for employment in permanent and conditional bus operator positions, as part-time and substitute bus operators, or for other positions requiring a commercial driver's license (CDL)

II. PROCEDURES

Referral and Examination of Applicants

- A. All applicants for permanent or conditional bus operator positions and applicants for part-time or substitute bus operator positions and positions requiring a CDL who are considered for employment are given a preemployment medical examination. Appointments for the examinations are scheduled by the applicant with a Board of Education approved physician.
- B. The initial examination is conducted at no cost to the applicant; however, any additional tests and/or medical information required by the examining physician must be provided at the applicant's expense.
