LEAD IN DRINKING WATER POST-REMEDIATION SAMPLE RESULTS SUMMARY

One drinking water outlet was remediated at Montgomery Knolls Elementary School due to an initial first draw concentration that exceeded the Action Level of 5 parts per billion (ppb). Inspections Experts Inc. collected a post-remediation follow-up first draw sample which was submitted to a laboratory for lead in water analysis. The laboratory has been certified by the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) to analyze drinking water for lead.
