



WHEREAS, Funds have been budgeted for the purchase of equipment, supplies, and contractual services; and

WHEREAS, Funds have been budgeted for the purchase and financing of off-the-lot, new vehicles and equipment for the Department of Transportation through Bid No. 1065344 in the amount of \$164,988; and

WHEREAS, Funds have been budgeted for the purchase of office furniture through Bid No. 4058.6 at the December 5, 2017, Board of Education meeting in the amount of \$117,855; and

WHEREAS, Funds have been budgeted for the purchase of classroom furniture through Bid No. 4114.5 at the November 14, 2017, Board of Education meeting in the amount of \$174,137; and

WHEREAS, The acquisition of off-the-lot, new vehicles and equipment for the Department of Transportation, office furniture, and classroom furniture through financing agreement has been reviewed by legal counsel; now therefore be it

Resolved, That off-the-lot, new vehicles and equipment for the Department of Transportation in the amount of \$164,988 be purchased and financed for a five-year term under the Master Lease/Purchase Agreement with Banc of America Public Capital Corporation; and be it further

Resolved, That office furniture in the amount of \$117,855 be purchased and financed for a six-year term under the Master Lease/Purchase Agreement with Banc of America Public Capital Corporation; and be it further

Resolved, That classroom furniture in the amount of \$174,137 be purchased and financed for a six-year term under the Master Lease/Purchase Agreement with Banc of America Public Capital Corporation; and be it further

Resolved, That the proceeds from the aforementioned financing be used to reimburse Montgomery County Public Schools accounts to the extent that such has been or will be acquired before closing; and be it further

Resolved, That the proceeds from the aforementioned financing be used to reimburse Montgomery County Public Schools accounts to the extent that such have been or will be acquired before closing; and be it further
