The following are questions and responses regarding RFP# 4931.1 Professional Learning for Bilingual and Biliteracy Programs

Question 1: Approximately, how many teachers, coaches and administrators will participate in the PD from each school?

Answer: There are approximately 180 facilitators of instruction (English/Spanish), 5 coaches and 10 administrators.

Question 2: Approximately, how many hours of PD in total and over what intervals of time?

Answer: Approximately 10 full day sessions spread out over the school year.

Question 3: Will the PD provided to teachers across schools or by school?

Answer: The PD will be provided to teachers across schools with differentiation based on individual schools' needs.

Question 4: Approximately, how many teachers in each school will be observed and coached and for how many hours over the course of the year?

Answer: Approximately 5-6 teachers per school observed and coached 3 times in the school year.

Question 5: Will observations and job-embedded coaching build on already established professional-learning-community structures in existence in the schools?

Answer: Yes.

Question 6: Will support be provided to an MCPS team of writers already in existence?

Answer: Possibly and open to other approaches.

Question 7: Approximately, how many hours of consultation are expected to be needed

Answer: See answer to question 4

Question 8: Approximately, how many school and district administrators will participate in the PD?

Answer: 10 school administrators, 8-10 district administrators.

Question 9: Approximately, how many hours of PD in total and over what intervals of time?

Answer: Approximately 10 full day sessions spread out over the school year.

Question 10: Approximately, how many staff members are expected to participate from each school?

Answer: There are approximately 18 - 31 facilitators per school site.

Question 11: Approximately, how many hours for each participant in total and over what intervals of time?

Answer: Approximately 10 sessions per participant spread out over the school year.

Question 12: Will this be a facet of the training described in (a) above or a separate training

Answer: What is this? If the question is will PD on items such as oracy, happen in the school-based PD, then yes is the answer.

Question 13: If the latter, approximately, how many teachers, coaches and administrators will participate in the PD?

Answer: See answer 1 and 3.

Question 14: How many hours of PD in total and over what intervals of time?

Answer: Approximately 10 full day sessions spread out over the school year.
