



Subject: Contract Approval for RFP No. 1063.6 Speech-Language Services for Students with Disabilities

This is a request for additional funds authorization for the annual contract awarded to multiple contractors under Request for Proposal No. 1063.6, Speech and Language Services for Students with Disabilities. Speech and Language services are provided to identified students in Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) as a primary service and related service, as mandated by the *Individuals with Disabilities in Education Act* and *Code of Maryland Regulations*. Services under the contract include screening and assessment of MCPS students suspected of having a speech and language disability, and once identified, students' needs are served in specific areas that impact their education, including articulation, language, voice, and fluency. The funding authorization and extension of the contract for Fiscal Year 2023 totaling \$900,000 was approved by the Board of Education at the Board Business Meeting on August 23, 2022, Resolution No. 414-22.

WHEREAS, Funds have been budgeted for Fiscal Year 2023, in the amount of \$2,300,000, for speech and language screening, assessment and services for Montgomery County Public Schools students under Request for Proposal No. 1063.6, Speech and Language Services for Students with Disabilities; now therefore be it
