Superintendent Recommendation:

The superintendent recommends that the Board of Education approve the request to expend up to the indicated values for procurement contracts of \$25,000 or more under the Annotated Code of Maryland, Education Article §5-112, §5-112 (a)(3), and Board of Education Policy DJA, *MCPS Procurement Practices and Bid Awards*, as applicable. These contracts can support districtwide purchases and may not be limited to a specific division. Every item represents requested authorization for 100 percent of the budget for that item, unless otherwise noted.

Formal bids and request for proposals were obtained and evaluated by the Department of Procurement, Division of Financial Management, in consultation with the users. The tabulations, cost comparisons, and budget account verifications are available in the Department of Procurement's files. Summary information about vendors that receive payments of \$25,000 or more during a fiscal year, July 1 through June 30 of the following calendar year, is available in the Funding Accountability and Transparency [database](#) on the Montgomery County Public Schools website. The information identifying vendors by names and locations is the information submitted on the Internal Revenue Service Form W-9 with local affiliates noted as applicable.
