



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

The Montgomery County Public Schools' (MCPS) Office of Strategic Initiatives is seeking Board of Education approval to purchase technology solutions (hardware and services) from CDW, LLC, through the Sourcewell technology solutions contract; and approval to finance a portion of these purchases through the Master Lease/Purchase Agreement with Banc of America Public Capital Corporation approved by the Board of Education. It is recommended that the Board of Education approve this contract through June 30, 2024.

This contract will be funded as follows: \$14,225,000 by MCPS Fiscal Year (FY) 2023–2028 approved Capital Improvements Program (CIP); \$10,836,900 is projected to be funded in the FY 2024 operating budget or the Independent Student Activity Funds; \$4,245,000 will be paid using Tech Mod funds; and \$9,980,000 will be financed over a four-year time period. Additionally, due to the COVID-19 health pandemic there has been a significant surge in technology infrastructure related purchases. Therefore, we have included \$13,660,946 in anticipated grant funding, including ECF and ESSER funding, bringing the contract total for the FY 2024 to \$38,722,846.

This transaction complies with state law and MCPS procurement regulations because the Sourcewell contract resulted from a competitive bid process. State law enables MCPS and other local school systems to purchase technology solutions through contracts awarded by public agencies and by intergovernmental purchasing organizations, such as this Sourcewell contract, so long as the lead agency or organization follows competitive public bidding procedures. Specifically, the Education Article's public bidding statute (Section 5-112) recognizes the ability of MCPS to enter into these competitively bid, cooperative agreements, and exempts the following from bid procedures:


