The Montgomery County Public Schools' (MCPS) Office of Strategic Initiatives is seeking Board of Education approval to purchase technology solutions (hardware and services) from CDW, LLC, through the Sourcewell technology solutions contract; and approval to finance a portion of these purchases through the Master Lease/Purchase Agreement with Banc of America Public Capital Corporation approved by the Board of Education.
