WHEREAS, Funds have been budgeted for the purchase and financing of off-the-lot new vehicles and equipment awarded through Bid No. 1065344, in the amount of \$214,081; and

WHEREAS, Funds have been budgeted for the purchase and financing of off-the-lot new vehicles and equipment awarded through Bid No. 1065347, in the amount of \$668,212; and

WHEREAS, Funds have been budgeted for the purchase and financing of lawn maintenance equipment awarded through Bid No. 7112.6, in the amount of \$103,250; and
