One Pill Can Kill & No One Is Immune

Panelists will share important information for families on the dangers and prevalence of fentanyl, prevention tools and protective factors for students, and resources for treatment. This is a family discussion about what you need to know about this deadly drug, including Narcan training and distribution to help reverse an overdose. Following the panel, there will be breakout sessions in English and Spanish for parents/caregivers. Students will have an opportunity to participate in their own breakout session. The Community Opioid Prevention & Education (C.O.P.E.) trailer (a mock teen bedroom) will be available for tours to learn signs of substance use.
