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Executive Summary

The 2003–2004 Surveys of School Environment (SSE), completed for the Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS), were designed to provide information about how students, parents, and school staff perceive their school environments. Survey respondents were asked to consider their own school’s environment in providing their responses.

Parents and students had highly positive perceptions of MCPS schools. Elementary school parent mean percentage of positive perceptions range from a low of 88.9% for Physical Environment to a high of 97.2% for Guidance. Middle school parent mean positive perceptions range from a low of 73.8% for Partnerships to a high of 89.8% for Social Environment, and high school parent mean positive perceptions range from a low of 71.7% for Partnerships to a high of 86.3% for Satisfaction.

Elementary students also have positive perceptions of MCPS elementary schools. Their mean positive perceptions range from a low of 65.7% for Physical Environment to a high of 89.2% for Guidance. Middle school student mean positive perceptions range from a low of 59.0% for Physical Environment to a high of 80.0% for Guidance. High school students have the same pattern seen for elementary and middle school students; their mean positive perceptions range from a low of 56.6% for Physical Environment to a high of 76.9% for Guidance.

MCPS staff members have positive perceptions of their schools. For staff in elementary, middle, and high schools, Physical Environment has the lowest mean percentage of positive perceptions ranging from 73.9% in elementary schools, to 72.5% in middle schools to 66.2% in high schools. Job Satisfaction had the highest positive perception for school staff, ranging from a low of 83.7% for middle schools to 88.5% for elementary schools.

It is important to increase response rates, particularly for parents and staff, and in isolated instances for students. Because the validity of data is affected by low response rates, some school-based results cannot be reported. When parent results were adjusted for differing representation by race/ethnicity, the positive perceptions showed an increase in all Broad Areas except Partnerships. This suggests that the lack of response may be related to the sense of connection parents feel to their children’s schools. By building that partnership a school would likely increase the response rate.

The Department of Shared Accountability (DSA) is investigating the level of effort required to develop a Web-based application to pilot online administration of the Student Survey of School Environment during the 2004–2005 school year. This would strengthen the confidentiality and streamline data collection and analysis. In future years, MCPS could explore development of an online, school-based staff survey to ensure a successful collaborative implementation.

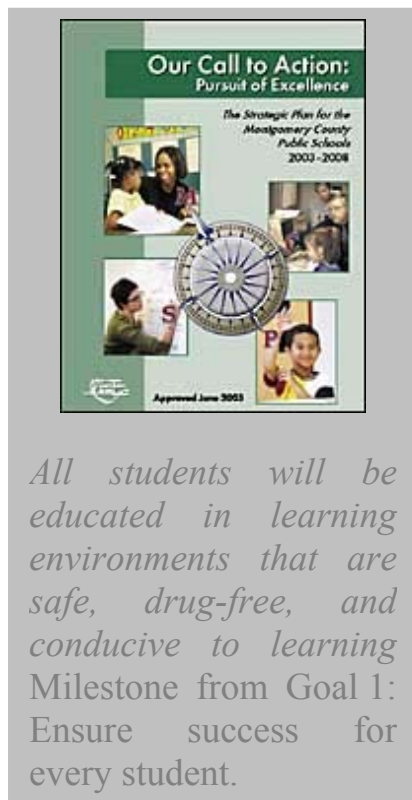

Background

The Surveys of School Environment (SSE) are designed to provide information about how parents, students, and staff perceive the school environment. The results provide information that can be used for discussion and school improvement. Results are reported for the Academic Environment, School Atmosphere and Communication, Guidance, School Safety and Discipline, and Social and Physical Environment of the Montgomery County Public Schools. Results are used for school improvement planning and as part of the MCPS strategic plan, *Our Call to Action: Pursuit of Excellence*.



All students will be educated in learning environments that are safe, drug-free, and conducive to learning Milestone from Goal 1: Ensure success for every student.

The Baldrige-guided school improvement process, which was implemented by Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) in 2001–2002, also involves understanding parent, student, and staff needs and expectations. The SSE is an additional source of information to support the Baldrige initiative, providing information about parents, students, as well as staff perceptions of their school environments.

The Development of the Surveys of School Environment

To design the surveys, staff from the Department of Shared Accountability (DSA) conducted a literature review on school quality through reviews of published research in the areas of effective schools and school climate, as well as an examination of existing national surveys (Griffith et al., 2001). Reviews of school effectiveness studies indicated that school attributes of quality or effectiveness cannot be summarized as one unitary dimension (Rothstein, 2000), but should represent many dimensions. A review of the literature conducted by DSA staff identified several attributes pertaining to school effectiveness, including

- parental involvement in children’s academic learning, especially during elementary school years (Epstein, 1991; Henderson & Berla, 1994; Johnson & Walker, 1991; Stevenson & Baker, 1987; Purkey & Smith, 1983; Lezotte, 1997);

- perceptions of school safety and discipline (Levine, 1992; Moos, 1979; Stockard & Mayberry, 1992; Lezotte, 1997);
- teachers' involvement with and collective responsibility for academic achievement (Lee & Loeb, 2000; Lee & Smith, 1996);
- school site management, strong leadership, curriculum articulation and organization, staff development, schoolwide recognition, and maximized learning time (Purkey & Smith, 1983; Lezotte, 1997; Scheerens, 1999; Sammons, 1999); and
- collaborative planning and collegial relationships, sense of community, clear goals and high expectations that are commonly shared, and order and discipline (Purkey & Smith, 1983; Lezotte, 1997; Scheerens, 1999, Sammons, 1999).

Pilot Testing the Surveys

The SSEs were pilot-tested with school-based staff and Grade 5 students and their parents in spring 2001. The first administration of the SSE occurred during the 2001–2002 school year. A survey work group was established to guide modifications and changes that had been suggested as a result of the first administration. The work group, chaired by the coordinating community superintendent, Office of School Performance, was convened in fall 2002. The group included representation from

- MCPS students;
- Montgomery County Council of Parent Teacher Associations (MCCPTA);
- Montgomery County Association of Administrative and Supervisory Personnel (MCAASP), Montgomery County Education Association (MCEA), and Service Employees International Union Local 500 (SEIU Local 500); and
- central office staff from the Office of School Performance, the DSA, and other MCPS central services offices.

Methodology

This section of the report will identify the research questions that will be addressed in the results section, and review the sampling, administration, and reporting procedures.

1. How many parents and students completed surveys during 2003–2004?
How has participation changed over time?
2. What do the parent and student survey results tell us about the school environment in MCPS by school level?
3. How many staff members responded and what do they report about MCPS schools?
4. How are survey results used for the MCPS strategic plan, *Our Call to Action: Pursuit of Excellence*?
5. How do schools use results for school improvement planning?

Sampling Frame

A sample of parents and students from every school was included in the survey. The sampling frame includes students in Grades 3, 5, 6, 8, 9, and 11; parents of students in those grades, Grade 2 for K–2 schools and, beginning in 2002–2003, parents of students in Grade 1. All school-based staff members were surveyed.

Survey Development

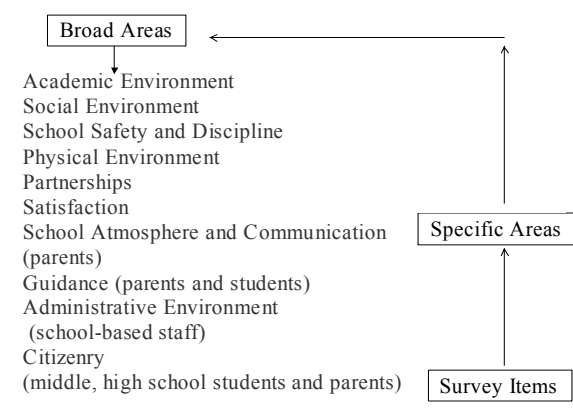


Figure 1. Surveys of school environment areas and structure.

Separate instruments were developed for students and parents at the elementary, middle, and high school levels, and a single instrument was designed for school-based staff. As illustrated in Figure 1, survey items are averaged into Specific Areas, which are in turn averaged into Broad Areas.

Administration of the Surveys

The surveys are distributed between February and April of each school year. Student surveys are administered during a window of six weeks. This allows school administrators and teachers some flexibility in the timing of the student survey administration so as not to interfere with the MCPS testing calendar.

Parent surveys are delivered in two ways. Elementary school students take surveys home to their parents, and parents of middle and high school students receive their surveys through the U.S. postal service. All parents are asked to return the surveys to the DSA in pre-addressed, postage-paid envelopes.

Since 2002–2003, school-based staff members have received their surveys at their work locations. The surveys may be returned through the MCPS Pony delivery system or by mail through the U. S. Postal Service with postage paid by MCPS.

Reporting of School and District Data

After completed surveys are received and scanned, a statistical review is conducted to determine if the responding sample is statistically representative of the school. Specific decision rules are reported in Appendix A. Appendix B reports percentages of schools with sufficient response rates to report results.

School-level results are calculated by first computing the percentage of individual respondents who had a positive perception for each item (that is, responded either “Agree” or “Strongly Agree”). The average of item percentages is used to represent the perception of respondents for Specific Areas; Specific Areas are then averaged to calculate the mean positive perception for a Broad Area.

Districtwide results are calculated by aggregating respondents from elementary, middle, and high schools. The mean positive perceptions for a Broad Area is the mean percentage of respondents who responded “Agree” or “Strongly Agree” on the items that are aggregated to a Specific Area and then averaged to a Broad Area.

Data are examined for representation and, if necessary, adjusted by using a weighting process to ensure proper representation so that results can be generalized. Parent data and staff data were found not to be representative and were adjusted by weighting; both raw response data and adjusted data are provided in all tables.

Results

This section reports results for parents, students, and staff and is organized to respond to the five questions identified in the methodology.

Parent and Student Respondents

The completion rates for the parent surveys continue to be low, while completion rates for students were higher. This pattern has been consistent over the three survey years. In 2003–2004, parents of elementary school students have the highest response rate at 22.5%, followed by middle school parents at 15.5%, and then high school parents at 12.5%. Similarly, response rates are highest for elementary students (88.3%), followed by middle school students (82.2%), and for high school students (64.9%). (See Table 1.)

Over the three years of data collection, elementary, middle, and high school parent participation declined from 26.8% to 22.5% for elementary, 17.5% to 15.5% for middle, and 15.1% to 12.5% for high schools. Student participation has declined for elementary students, from 93.3% in 2001–2002 to 88.3% in 2003–2004, and for high school students, from 72.2% to 64.9%. Middle school students rose from 80.2% in 2001–2002 to 82.2% in 2003–2004.

Parent and Student Perceptions

Overall, responding groups perceived their school environments positively. Perceptions of the school environment for all three school levels were fairly high; a majority of Broad Areas were viewed positively by at least 75% of the parent respondents at all levels and by student respondents in elementary schools.

Elementary Schools

Parents report high rates of satisfaction with their children's elementary schools. Parent mean positive perceptions range from a low of 88.9% for Physical Environment to a high of 97.2% for Guidance (see Table 2). Parent data were adjusted to better represent the race/ethnicity of MCPS parents; the adjustment resulted in an increase in the mean percentage of parents with a positive perception in all Broad Areas except Partnerships. These results suggest that parents who do not complete a survey may feel less positively about the partnership they have with their children's school.

Elementary students also have a positive perception of MCPS elementary schools. Their mean positive perceptions range from a low of 65.7% for Physical Environment to a high of 89.2% for Guidance.

Middle Schools

Middle school parents report positive perceptions for all Broad Areas. Parent mean positive perceptions range from a low of 73.8% for Partnerships to a high of 89.8% for Social Environment (see Table 3). Parent data were adjusted to better represent the race/ethnicity of MCPS parents; the adjustment resulted in an increase in mean percentage of parents with a positive perception for all Broad Areas except Partnerships. This decline suggests that parents who are not as well represented in the results feel less positively about their partnership with the school.

Middle school students also have a positive perception of MCPS middle schools. Their mean positive perceptions range from a low of 59.0% for Physical Environment to a high of 80.0% for Guidance.

High Schools

Similar patterns occur at the high school level. High school parents report positive perceptions for all Broad Areas. Mean positive perception ranges from a low of 71.7% for Partnerships to a high of 87.0% for Satisfaction (see Table 4). Parent data were adjusted to better represent the race/ethnicity of MCPS parents; the adjustment resulted in an increase in mean percentage of parents with positive perceptions for all Broad Areas except Partnerships. As noted in the elementary and middle school parent results, this decrease in positive perceptions of Partnerships

after the data are adjusted suggests that parents who did not complete the survey feel less positively about the partnership they have with their children's school.

High school students have the same pattern as elementary and middle school students. The mean positive perceptions ranges from a low of 56.6% for Physical Environment to a high of 76.9% for Guidance.

Staff Respondents and Perceptions

Overall, the number of school-based staff members who responded to the survey has increased over the three years (see Table 5). Participation of elementary school and middle school staff increased by almost 10 percentage points over the 3-year period and by more than 8 percentage points for high school staff.

Response rates for staff are the highest for the 2003–2004 school year. A total of 3,462 elementary staff (44.9%), 1,458 middle school staff (39.0%), and 1,431 high school staff (31.8%) completed and returned surveys.

MCPS staff have positive perceptions of their schools. For elementary, middle, and high school staff, Physical Environment has the lowest mean percentage of positive perceptions. The highest is Job Satisfaction, ranging from 83.7% for middle schools to 88.5% for elementary schools.

Survey Results in the MCPS Strategic Plan

Results from the SSE for the Broad Area School Safety and Discipline are used as data points to monitor *Goal 1 Ensure Success for Every Student*. Data relevant to the milestone, “All students will be educated in learning environments that are safe, drug-free, and conducive to learning,” is presented in Figure 3. The data points show that the positive perceptions are all above 60%.

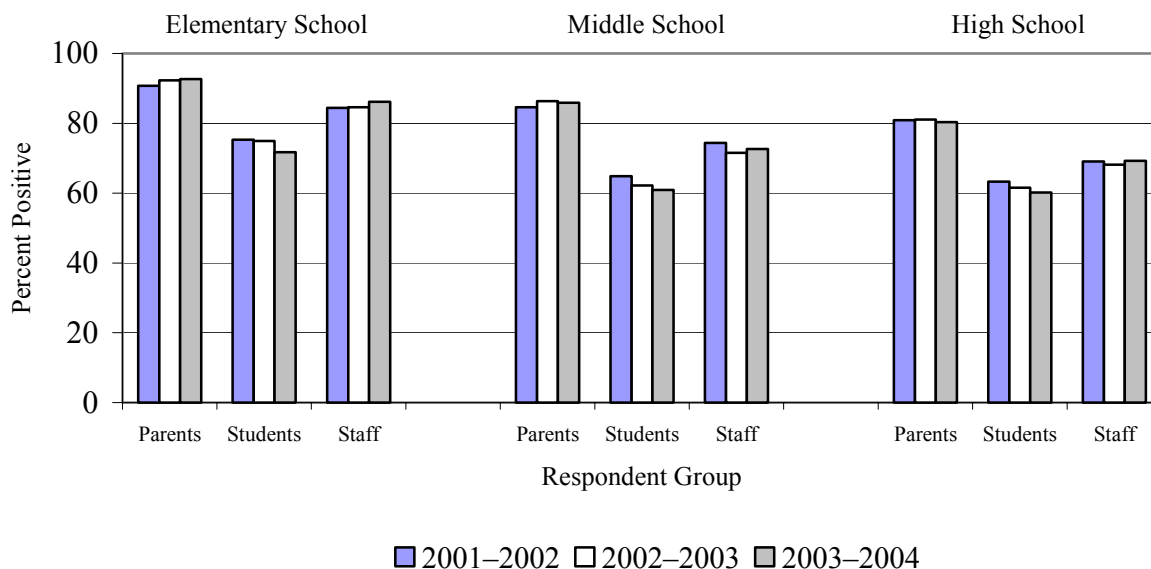


Figure 2. Parent, student, and school-based staff by school-level positive perceptions of School Safety and Discipline.

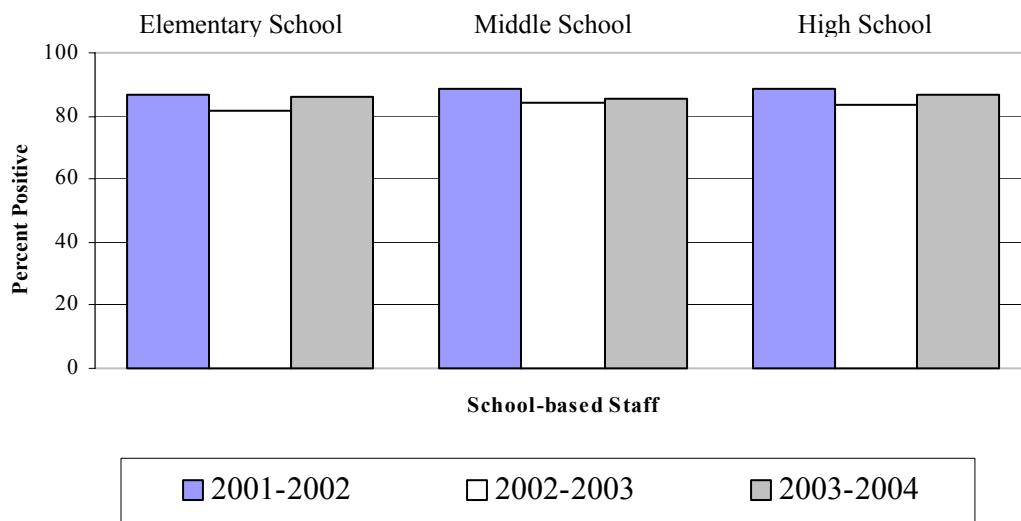


Figure 3. School-based staff by school level positive perceptions of Job Satisfaction.

For *Goal 4: Create a Positive Work Environment in a Self-renewing Organization*, the SSE responds to the milestone: *The work environment promotes employee well-being, satisfaction, and positive morale*. Figure 3 shows the job satisfaction of MCPS employees. The data points show that the positive perceptions are all above 80%.

School Improvement

Detailed survey results are made available to the schools so that principals and others involved in school improvement planning can review and use the data, both as feedback and as a planning mechanism in focusing on goals for the upcoming school year.

Survey results are being used in schools in a variety of ways. One elementary school principal reviewed results with the PTA president as a mechanism to increase parental involvement in the school. Another elementary principal reported in a letter to parents and guardians that the results had been reviewed with the PTA leadership to address identified issues. A middle school principal shared parent and student survey results in a schoolwide newsletter, along with a discussion of areas of strength and areas needing improvement that were identified in the survey. Several schools, including elementary, middle, and high schools, informed the Office of Organizational Development that they shared results and implications at meetings and in newsletters and documented the process in their School Improvement Team (SIT) notes and plans. The SIT used this input, along with additional information it identified from other groups, to develop their mission, vision, and goals for the school; and they referred back to the survey results throughout the year.

Discussion and Recommendations

Parents and students have highly positive perceptions of MCPS schools. Elementary school parent mean percentage of positive perceptions ranges from a low of 88.9% for Physical Environment to a high of 97.2% for Guidance. Middle school parents have a mean positive perception that ranges from a low of 73.8% for Partnerships to a high of 89.8% for Social Environment. High school parent mean positive perceptions range from a low of 71.7% for Partnerships to a high of 86.3% for Satisfaction.

Elementary students also have a positive perception of MCPS elementary schools. Their mean positive perception ranges from a low of 65.7% for Physical Environment to a high of 89.2% for Guidance. Middle school students have mean positive perceptions ranging from a low of 59.0% for Physical Environment to a high of 80.0% for Guidance. High school students have the same pattern seen for elementary and middle school students; their mean positive perceptions range from a low of 56.6% for Physical Environment to a high of 76.9% for Guidance.

MCPS staff members have positive perceptions of their schools. For elementary, middle, and high school staff, Physical Environment has the lowest mean percentage of positive perceptions. The highest is Job Satisfaction, ranging from 83.7% for middle schools to 88.5% for elementary schools.

Recommendation 1: Explore options to increase response rate.

It is important to increase response rates, particularly for parents and staff, and in isolated instances for students. Because the validity of data is affected by low response rates, some school-based results cannot be reported. When parent results were adjusted for differing representation by race/ethnicity, the positive perceptions increased in all Broad Areas except Partnerships. This suggests that response rates may be related to the sense of connection parents feel to their children's schools. Parent involvement has been shown to be an important ingredient for increased student performance (Epstein, 1991). Increasing activities to help parents feel more connected to their schools may help to build and support a partnership and may likely increase the response rate.

Staff from the DSA will continue to investigate options and present them to stakeholders to consider as possibilities to improve response rates. Possible options include administering the survey every three years, creating an online instrument, shortening the survey, and administering the survey to all students and parents.

Recommendation 2: Pilot test administration of Web-based student survey in spring 2005.

Create a Web-based application to pilot during the 2004–2005 school year. This would increase confidentiality and streamline data collection and analysis. In future years, MCPS can explore the possibility of developing an online, school-based staff survey to ensure a successful collaborative implementation.

The SSE results provide data related to the perceptions of parents, students, and staff for *Our Call to Action: Pursuit of Excellence*, the MCPS strategic plan. These data will be used in conjunction with other data to monitor progress in achieving the goals of the strategic plan. This report will make this data available to the Board of Education, the superintendent, and MCPS administrators to be used for tracking progress in achieving the goals and objectives identified in the strategic plan.

Recommendation 3: The SSE should be used to support school improvement and Baldrige activities.

The SSEs were specifically designed to facilitate school improvement planning at the school level and to provide information for school improvement plans. The data are released to school leadership teams so that principals and others involved in school improvement planning can review data, reflect on changes that have occurred, and use data to review prior initiatives and plan for future initiatives. Survey results also are used to enable school leadership teams to identify areas where they may want to clarify issues or concerns with stakeholders.

Appendix A

Decision Rules for Reporting School-level Data

Parent Surveys

1. Rank by median number of respondents by school level; top 50% are reported.
2. Rank by median percentage of respondents by school level; top 50% are reported.
3. For the remaining schools that have not been reported
 - a. If the number of completed surveys is greater than or equal to 30, a chi-square analysis on race/ethnicity, with a significance level of 0.10 is performed. If the test is significant, indicating that there is a difference between the sample and the population, the results are not reported.
 - b. If the number of completed surveys is less than 30, results are not reported.

Student Surveys

1. Any school with a response rate of less than 50% is not reported, since there is evidence of uneven administration at the school, i.e., not all students had an opportunity to complete the survey.

Staff Surveys

1. Rank by median number of respondents by school level; top 50% are reported.
2. Rank by median percentage of respondents by school level; top 50% are reported.
3. For the remaining schools that have not been reported, if the number of completed surveys is 30 or more, a chi-square analysis is performed on staff job classification and on years of service (less than 3 years and greater than 3 years), with a significance level of 0.10. If the chi-square test is significant, indicating that there is a difference between the sample and the population, the results are not reported.
