MEMORANDUM

Subject: Grade 5 Enrollment in and Successful Completion of Math A or
Higher-Level Mathematics

The districtwide priority to increase Grade 5 student enrollment in and successful completion of secondary level mathematics is showing strong results. Student mathematics performance is continually monitored. Proficiency is demonstrated by meeting established standards on local assessments. As a result, acceleration can occur at various times throughout a student's mathematics studies.

Overall, 45 percent of last year's Grade 5 students were enrolled in Math A (Math 6) or higher-level mathematics, which includes Math B (Math 7), Math C (Algebra Prep), Investigations into Mathematics (IM), or Algebra 1. As indicated in the attached report, *Successful Completion of Math A or Higher-Level Mathematics by the End of Grade 5*, during the 2006–2007 school year, 38.9 percent of all Grade 5 students successfully completed Math A or higher-level mathematics (as measured by meeting the proficiency standard on unit assessments). Compared with the prior year, successful completion of Math A or higher-level mathematics increased for all students.

Rigorous expectations for the successful completion of Math A or higher-level mathematics by the end of Grade 5 have been established for all students and all groups of students. During 2006-2007, the completion rate for all Asian American and White students exceeded expectation.

We will continue to keep you informed about student progress in the important area of higher-level mathematics completion in elementary schools.

Successful Completion of Math A or Higher-Level Mathematics by the End of Grade 5

The Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) is committed to providing an aligned, high-quality curriculum from prekindergarten through Grade 12. This effort is designed to ensure that all students in every school receive the proper foundation and sequence of essential skills and knowledge that will prepare them for success in the next grade. Ultimately, the school system's objective is to prepare all students to be successful after high school—in college, other postsecondary studies, or a career in the world of work. Mathematics is key to this effort. To achieve this goal, MCPS provides the opportunity for accelerated mathematics studies beginning in elementary school.

The districtwide priority to increase Grade 5 student enrollment in and successful completion of secondary level mathematics is showing strong results. During the 2000–2001 school year, there were 196 Grade 5 students enrolled in Math A (Math 6) or higher-level mathematics, most of whom were students in the Elementary Centers for the Highly Gifted. During 2006–2007, as a direct result of the acceleration that has been taking place in elementary schools over the past few years, approximately 4,500 or 45 percent of all Grade 5 students were enrolled in Math A or higher-level mathematics, which include Math B (Math 7), Math C (Algebra Prep), Investigations into Mathematics, or Algebra 1 (Table 1).

Compared with the prior year, 2006–2007 enrollment in Math A or higher increased for all students and for all groups of students. Enrollment of White students increased by more than 9 percentage points. Enrollment of Hispanic and Asian American students increased by more than 6 percentage points. Enrollment of African American, limited English proficient (LEP), and special education students increased by more than 4 percentage points (Table 1).

During the 2006–2007 school year, 38.9 percent of all Grade 5 students successfully completed Math A or higher-level mathematics (as measured by meeting the proficiency standard determined by cumulative performance on MCPS mathematics unit assessments). Among racial/ethnic groups, Asian American and White students had the highest completion rates. Among students receiving special services, Free and Reduced-price Meals System (FARMS) students had the highest completion rate, followed by special education and LEP students (Table 2).

Compared with the prior year, successful completion of Math A or higher-level mathematics increased for all students and all groups of students during the 2006–2007 school year. The completion rate among Asian American and White students increased by more than 11 percentage points, while the completion rate among all students increased by more than 9 percentage points. Among African American and Hispanic students, the rate of successful completion increased by more than 5 percentage points (Table 2).

Strategic Plan Improvement Targets

Rigorous expectations for all students and all groups of students have been established for the successful completion of Math A or higher-level mathematics by the end of Grade 5. The targets for Math A completion are twofold—the student performance target designates the percentage of all Grade 5 students and all groups of Grade 5 students enrolled in a comprehensive elementary school that successfully meet or exceed the expected completion rate, while the district target designates the percentage of comprehensive elementary schools having all Grade 5 students and all groups of Grade 5 students at or above the expected completion rate.

During 2006–2007, 33.3 percent of all students and all groups of students were expected to successfully complete Math A by the end of Grade 5 (Table 3.) Over the next three years, the student level target for the completion of Math A or higher by the end of Grade 5 rises approximately 4 percentage points a year to 45 percent in 2010.

The 2007 district target expects 74 out of 119 of all comprehensive elementary schools serving Grade 5 students to have 33.3 percent of all Grade 5 students and student groups successfully completing Math A or higher-level mathematics by the end of Grade 5. During 2006–2007, 83 out of 119 elementary schools met the target for their Asian American students and 93 elementary schools met the target for their White students (Table 4). However, 73 schools met expectation for all students, 14 schools met expectation for African American students, 25 schools met expectation for Hispanic students, 3 schools met expectation for LEP students, 7 schools met expectation for FARMS students, and 8 schools met expectation for special education students.
