

## Results for the 2007 Spring Reading Benchmark Assessments

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### Background

Goal 2 of the Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) strategic plan, *Our Call to Action: Pursuit of Excellence* (MCPS, 2007–2012), is to provide an effective instructional program. One milestone toward meeting this goal is that all students will acquire the essential skills and knowledge to meet or exceed standards in reading and mathematics by the end of Grade 2. The MCPS Assessment Program—Primary Reading (MCPS AP-PR)—is designed to measure foundational reading skills and reading proficiency in kindergarten, first, and second grades. Thus, MCPS AP-PR is an important data point for measuring attainment of this milestone. The purpose of this brief is to—

- provide the percentage of students in kindergarten, Grade 1 and 2 who met the grade-level reading benchmark; and
- provide the percentage of students who participated in the 2006–2007 administration of the MCPS AP-PR.

MCPS AP-PR is a combination of a locally developed assessment and a nationally norm-referenced assessment. The goal of this assessment is to provide continuous information about students' reading development including reading accuracy, oral reading fluency, and comprehension. Benchmarks are established at kindergarten, first, and second grades to assess literacy skills.

MCPS AP-PR is administered in the fall, winter, and spring. The 2006–2007 end-of-year benchmark for kindergarten is for students to read level 3 text with 90% or higher accuracy and demonstrate comprehension on a retelling measure. Grade 1 students must read level 16 text or higher with 90% or higher accuracy and achieve a score of at least 4 out of 5 on oral comprehension. Grade 2 students must read level M text or higher with 90% or higher accuracy, have an oral comprehension score of at least 4 out of 5, and score at least 2 out of 3 on two written comprehension items. Students can reach the benchmark during any one of the three test administrations.

### Methodology

The results reported in this brief represent the percentage of students enrolled May 31, 2007, who took the MCPS AP-PR and the percentage of test takers who met the 2007 end-of-year benchmark. Results are reported for the district overall, by gender, race/ethnicity, and service group—Free and Reduced-price Meals System (FARMS), special education and English Language Learner (ELL).

All elementary schools with kindergarten, first, and second grades participated in the MCPS AP-PR with exception of the four Reading First elementary schools (Highland, Wheaton Woods, Rosemont, and Summit Hall) and students participating in a total French or Spanish immersion program (Rock Creek Forest, Sligo Creek, and Maryvale).

MCPS established a new Grade 2 baseline in spring 2006. Therefore, data are only provided for the last two years. In addition, due to the small number of American Indian students tested, they are not reported as a separate category but are included in the analysis.

### Results

#### Kindergarten

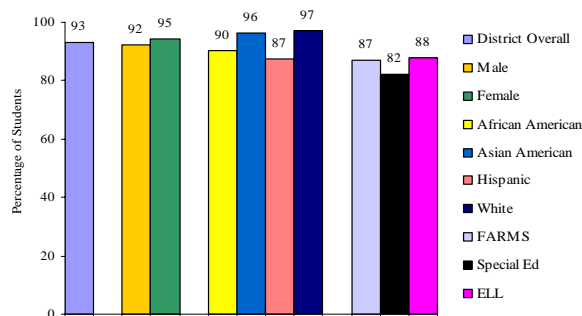


Figure 1. Percentage of kindergarten students meeting benchmark by district, gender, race/ethnicity, and service groups in 2006–2007.

In 2006–2007, 93% of kindergarten students met or exceeded the MCPS AP-PR benchmark (Figure 1), a 25 percentage-point increase from 2002–2003 (Appendix A, Figure A1).

Between 2002 and 2007, the percentage of African American students who met or exceeded the benchmark increased by 25 percentage points while the percentage of Hispanic students who met or exceeded the benchmark increased by 32 percentage points. Asian American and White students had increases of 20 and 24 percentage points, respectively, during the same period (Appendix A, Figure A1). The five-year gains among students who received FARMS, special education, and ELL services were 29, 32, and 40 percentage points, respectively (Appendix A, Figure A2).

### First Grade

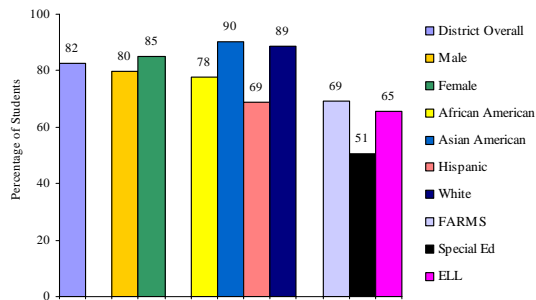


Figure 2. Percentage of Grade 1 students meeting benchmark by district, gender, race/ethnicity and service groups in 2006–2007.

Overall, 82% of students in Grade 1 met or exceeded the end-of-year benchmark (Figure 2). Increases among student groups in Grade 1 over the five year period ranged from 17 to 37 percentage points. The percentage of students who met or exceeded the benchmark in Grade 1 increased by 24 percentage points for African American students, 26 percentage points for Hispanic students, 21 percentage points for Asian American and 17 percentage points for White students (Appendix B, Figure B1). The five-year gains among students who received FARMS, special education, and ELL services were 27, 17, and 37 percentage points, respectively (Appendix B, Figure B2).

### Second Grade

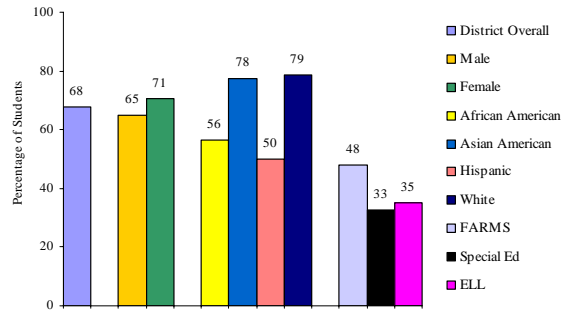


Figure 3. Percentage of Grade 2 students meeting benchmark by district, gender, race/ethnicity and service groups in 2006–2007.

Sixty-eight percent of Grade 2 students met or exceeded the end-of-year benchmark during the 2006–2007 school year (Figure 3), a 13 percentage-point increase from 2005–2006. The one-year increases among student groups ranged from 4 to 14 percentage points. The percentage of African American students who met or exceeded the benchmark increased by 11 percentage points, Hispanic students by 10 percentage points, and both Asian American and White students by 14 percentage points (Appendix C, Figure C1). The one-year increases among students who received FARMS, special education, and ELL services were 11, 4, and 12 percentage points, respectively (Appendix C, Figure C2).

### Gender by Race/Ethnicity and Service Provision

A higher percentage of female than male students met or exceeded the MCPS AP-PR benchmark in kindergarten (3 percentage points), Grade 1 (5 percentage points), and Grade 2 (6 percentage points). This gender difference is consistent with other standardized assessments such as the TerraNova Second Edition (TN/2), the Maryland School Assessment (MSA) and the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP).

When disaggregated by race/ethnicity and service provision, variability exists (Appendix A, Figures A3–A4, Appendix B, Figures B3–B4, and Appendix C, Figures C3–C4). However, data are consistent with the differences at the given grade level with the exception of African American students at Grade 1, where females outperformed male students by 8 percentage points, and at kindergarten and Grade 2 where male special education students outperformed female special education students by 4 and 5 percentage points, respectively.

### School Performance

The percentage of students who met or exceeded the benchmark at each grade level varies by school (Appendix D, Tables D1–D3). The greatest variability occurs for Grade 2. When comparing the highest performing school (98% of students met the MCPS AP-PR benchmark) for Grade 2 with the lowest performing school (23%), a 75 percentage-point difference was observed. For kindergarten, the difference was about 25 percentage points, and for Grade 1, the difference was about 46 percentage points.

### Participation

The participation rate was 93% in kindergarten, 97% in Grade 1, and 98% in Grade 2. The participation rate at each grade level was similar across subgroups, with the exception of the special education subgroup where the participation rate was 75% in kindergarten, 88% in Grade 1, and 92% in Grade 2 (Appendix D, Tables D4–D6).

## Conclusion

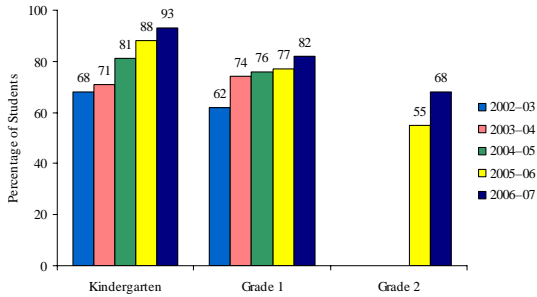


Figure 4: Percentage of students who met benchmark by grade between 2002 and 2007.

There were consistent gains in the percentage of all students and student groups in kindergarten and Grade 1 who met or exceeded the benchmark over the past five years (Figure 4). One year gains were seen for all grades and all student subgroups between 2005–2006 and 2006–2007.

## Recommendations

- Approximately 93% of MCPS kindergarten students met or exceeded the MCPS AP-PR benchmark in 2006–2007. Based on this extremely high level of attainment, the Office of Curriculum and Instructional Programs, Office of School Performance, and the Department of Shared Accountability (DSA) recommend moving the kindergarten benchmark from a level 3 to a level 4 text for the 2008–2009 school year. DSA will evaluate raising the benchmark to a level 5 text or higher in subsequent years. By not moving the benchmark and continuing with the current standard, there is a ceiling effect. This may prevent accurately identifying non-proficient students as meeting or exceeding the benchmark.
- Professional development will need to be provided to teachers who work with kindergarten students to support the change in the benchmark.
- As we continue to review the benchmark data at Grade 2, it will be important to analyze each component of the MCPS AP-PR assessment including text level, fluency, oral comprehension, and written comprehension by student groups.
- The differences in reading performance by gender will be monitored by DSA for each grade, race/ethnicity, and service group to assess any changes that may occur during

future administrations.

- DSA also will conduct further examination into student performance on the MCPS AP-PR benchmark and TN/2 at Grade 2 as well as the Measures of Academic Progress-Reading (MAP-R) and MSA scores of students in Grade 3. These analyses will be conducted to validate the utility of the benchmark as appropriate indicators of student achievement, as well as to monitor progress toward Goal 2 of the MCPS strategic plan.

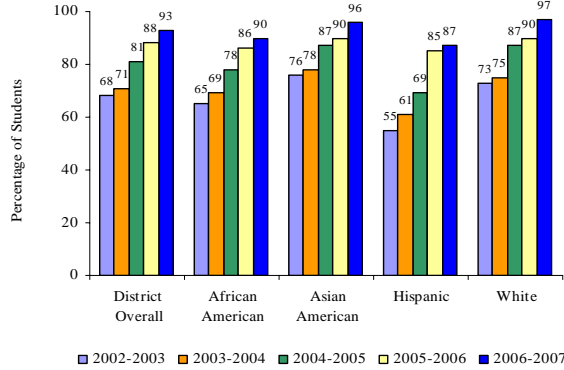


Figure A1: Percentage of kindergarten students who met the grade-level benchmark for the district overall and by race/ethnicity between 2002–2003 and 2006–2007.

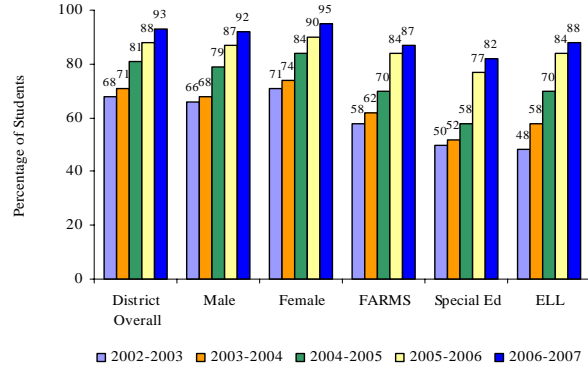


Figure A2: Percentage of kindergarten students who met the grade-level benchmark for the district overall, by gender and service group between 2002–2003 and 2006–2007.

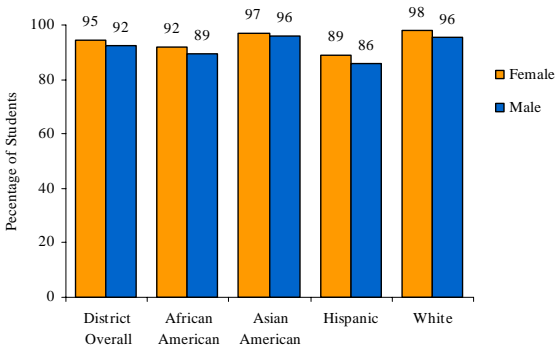


Figure A3: Percentage of kindergarten students who met the grade-level benchmark for the district overall and by race/ethnicity disaggregated by gender.

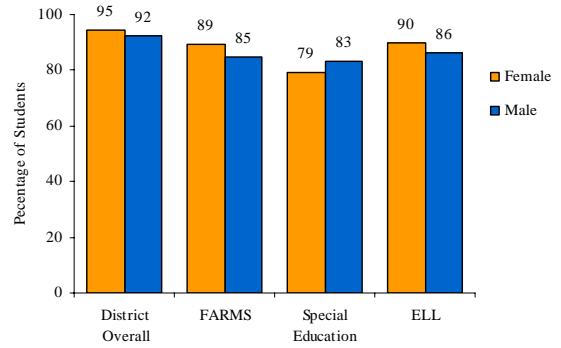


Figure A4: Percentage of kindergarten students who met the grade-level benchmark for the district overall and by service group disaggregated by gender.

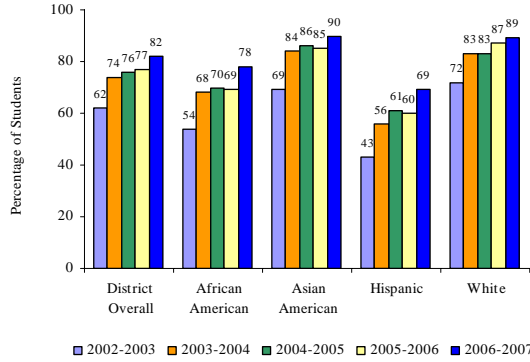


Figure B1: Percentage of Grade 1 students who met the grade-level benchmark for the district overall and by race/ethnicity between 2002–2003 and 2006–2007.

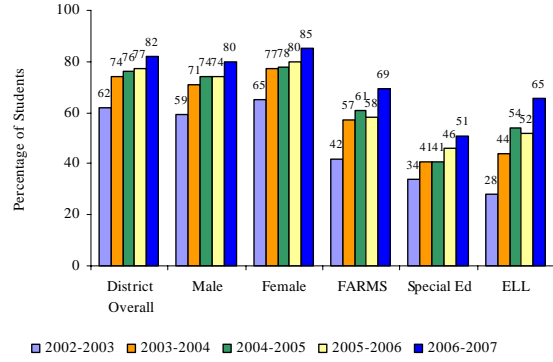


Figure B2: Percentage of Grade 1 students who met the grade-level benchmark for the district overall, gender and by service group between 2002–2003 and 2006–2007.

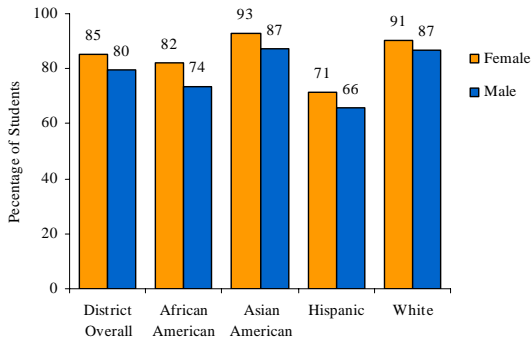


Figure B3: Percentage of Grade 1 students who met the grade-level benchmark for the district overall and by race/ethnicity disaggregated by gender.

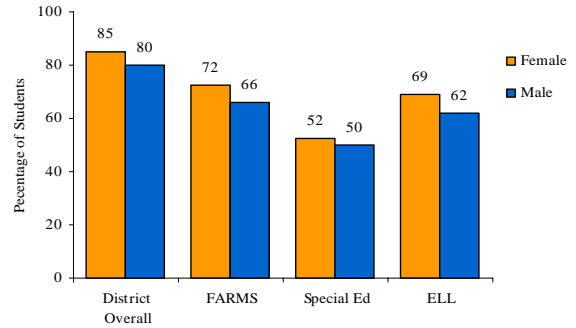


Figure B4: Percentage of Grade 1 students who met the grade-level benchmark for the district overall and by service group disaggregated by gender.

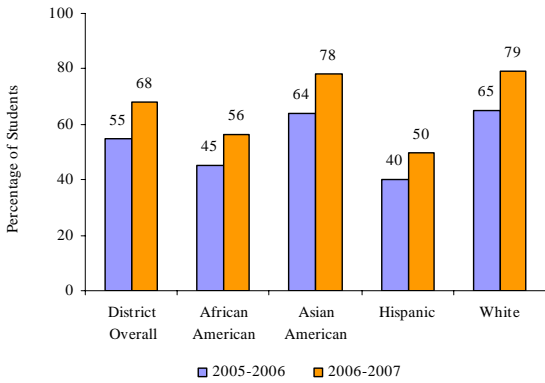


Figure C1: Percentage of Grade 2 students who met the grade-level benchmark for the district overall and by race/ethnicity between 2005–2006 and 2006–2007.

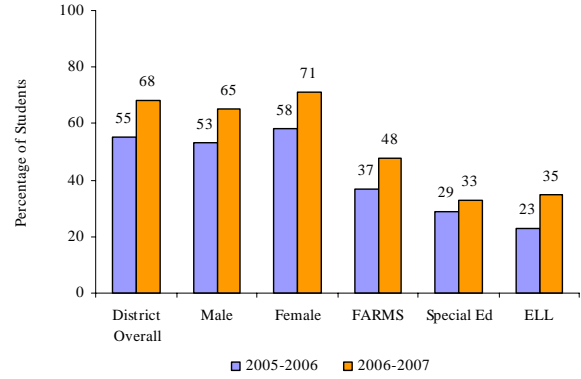


Figure C2: Percentage of Grade 2 students who met the grade-level benchmark for the district overall, gender and by service group between 2005–2006 and 2006–2007.

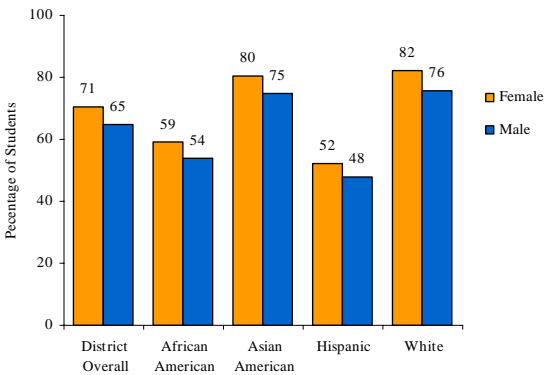


Figure C3: Percentage of Grade 2 students who met the grade-level benchmark for the district overall and by race/ethnicity disaggregated by gender.

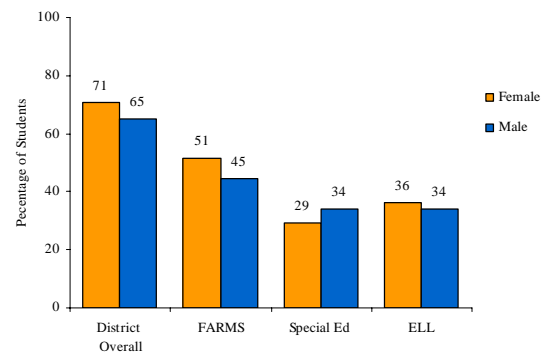


Figure C4: Percentage of Grade 2 students who met the grade-level benchmark for the district overall and by service group disaggregated by gender.
