MEMORANDUM

Subject: 2006–2007 Suspension Data

The attached tables on the most recent suspension data are provided as part of ongoing efforts to increase accountability for addressing and reducing the suspension rates in our schools. The data include 2006–2007 end-of-year suspension figures, along with data from the prior three years. Additionally, baseline data for the 1999–2000 school year are provided. Compared with last year, the countywide rate of out-of-school suspensions for all students decreased by 0.2 percentage point to 4.5 percent. However, since the baseline year, the rate has been gradually increasing for all students and all groups of students.

At all school levels, the district continues to implement programs and monitor efforts to eliminate the disproportionate suspension rates among student subgroups. Rigorous expectations have been established for all students and all groups of students and include student and district level targets for rates of suspension. The student-level target designates the percentage of all students and all groups of students at or below the expected suspension rate, while the district-level target designates the percentage of schools having all students and all groups of students at or below the expected suspension rate.

During the 2006–2007 school year, the suspension rates among elementary, middle, and high school Asian American and White students continue to be at or below the expected rate. The suspension rates for all students and all other groups of students were above the expected rates.

The 2006–2007 elementary school district level target expected at least 96 of the 129 comprehensive elementary schools to have suspension rates at or below 1.3 percent. The target was met by 110 schools for Asian American students and 99 schools for White students. The 2006–2007 middle school district level target expected at least 23 of the 38 comprehensive middle schools to have suspension rates at or below 7.2 percent. The target was met by 33 schools for both Asian American and White students. The 2006–2007 high school district level

target expected at least 15 of the 25 comprehensive high schools to have suspension rates at or below 6.5 percent. The target was met by 24 schools for Asian American students and 20 schools for White students.
