MEMORANDUM

Subject: 2007–2008 Suspension Data

The attached tables containing the most recent suspension data are provided as part of ongoing efforts to increase accountability for addressing and reducing the suspension rates in our schools. The data include 2007–2008 end-of-year suspension figures, along with data from the prior two years. Additionally, baseline data for the 1999–2000 school year are provided. Compared with last year, the countywide rate of out-of-school suspensions for all students decreased by 0.6 percentage point to 4.0 percent. However, since the baseline year, the rate has been gradually increasing for all students and all groups of students.

At all school levels, the district continues to implement programs and monitor efforts to eliminate the disproportionate suspension rates among student subgroups. Rigorous expectations have been established for all students and all groups of students and include student and district-level targets for rates of suspension. The student-level target designates the percentage of all students and all groups of students at or below the expected suspension rate, while the district-level target designates the percentage of schools having all students and all groups of students at or below the expected suspension rate.

During the 2007–2008 school year, the suspension rates among elementary, middle, and high school in the following categories: All Students, Asian American, and White students continue to be at or below the expected rate. The suspension rates for most of the other groups of students were above the expected rates.

The 2007–2008 elementary school district-level target expected at least 111 of the 130 comprehensive elementary schools to have suspension rates at or below 1.3 percent. The target was met by 112 schools for Asian American students. The 2007–2008 middle school district-level target expected at least 29 of the 38 comprehensive middle schools to have suspension rates

at or below 7.0 percent. The target was met by 36 schools for Asian American students and 35 schools for White students. The 2007–2008 high school district-level target expected at least 19 of the 25 comprehensive high schools to have suspension rates at or below 6.5 percent. The target was met by 25 schools for Asian American students and 22 schools for White students.
