SUBJECT: **Class of 2020 Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate Exam Participation and Performance**

Summary

- This memorandum provides information pertinent to the participation and performance of Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) examinations for 2020 graduates in Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS). In 2020, 66.6 percent of MCPS graduates took one or more AP exams, a rate that was 20.8 and 28.3 percentage points higher than the rate for public school graduates in Maryland (45.8 percent) and the nation (38.3 percent), respectively. Districtwide, 52.3 percent of the 2020 MCPS graduates earned at least one AP exam score of 3 or higher, while 31.5 percent of the public school graduates in the state of Maryland and 24.4 percent of the national graduates in public schools attained an AP score of 3 or higher.
- Among the focus groups, graduates who identified as Asian, White, and all other student groups and did not receive Free and Reduced-price Meals System (FARMS) services had the highest AP exam participation rate (62.0 percent) in 2020, while graduates who identified as Hispanic/Latino and received FARMS services (43.2 percent) had the lowest rate in 2020. Of the graduates who were represented in focus groups, those who identified as Asian, White, and all other student groups and receiving FARMS services had the highest AP exam performance rate (47.5 percent) in 2020, which represented the largest increase (5.8 percentage points from 2018 to 2020) in AP/IB exam performance among student groups.
- From 2018 to 2020, Clarksburg, Damascus, Richard Montgomery, and Northwest high schools demonstrated increases in both AP exam participation and performance for graduates identified as Black or African American and Hispanic/Latino.
- Districtwide, IB exam participation declined slightly by 0.8 percentage points in the last three years. The proportion of graduates who earned at least one IB exam score of 4 or higher remained flat from 2018 to 2020 (8.0 percent to 7.8 percent, respectively).
- Graduates identified as Hispanic/Latino graduates and receiving FARMS services had the highest IB exam participation rate (9.7 percent) in 2020. In 2020, graduates identified as Asian, White, and all other student groups and receiving FARMS services had the highest IB exam performance rate (8.2 percent), while the rate for graduates identified as Hispanic/Latino and did not receive FARMS services had the lowest performance rate (6.1 percent).
- In 2020, the proportion of graduates who took at least one IB exam ranged from 21.1 to 44.6 percent. The percentage of graduates in the Class of 2020 who earned at least one IB score of 4 or higher varied from 15.44 to 37.5 percent across all IB schools. From 2018 to 2020, three of the eight high schools with IB programs—Bethesda-Chevy Chase, Albert Einstein, and Springbrook high schools—demonstrated an increase in both IB exam participation and performance for all students.
