SUBJECT: ***Class of 2022 Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate Exam Participation and Performance***

Summary

- This memorandum provides information pertinent to the participation and performance of Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) examinations for 2022 graduates in Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS). In 2022, 63.2% of MCPS graduates took one or more AP exams—21.9 percentage points more than public school graduates in Maryland and 28.6 percentage points more than those in the Nation. Districtwide, 48.5 % of 2022 MCPS graduates earned at least one AP exam score of 3 or higher, while 27.4% of public school graduates in Maryland and 21.6% of graduates in the Nation.
- The three-year trend data for AP exam participation and performance for graduates who identified as Black or African American and Hispanic/Latino continued to rise across MCPS high schools. From 2020 to 2022, Bethesda Chevy-Chase, Albert Einstein, and Poolesville high schools demonstrated an increase in AP exam participation for graduates who identified as Black or African American and Hispanic/Latino. Watkins Mill high school demonstrated an increase in AP exam performance for graduates identified as Black or African American and Hispanic/Latino.
- Districtwide, the IB exam participation rate for the 2022 graduates was 7.4%, a decrease of 1.8 percentage points from 9.2% in 2020 but the same rate as for the 2021 graduates. The percentage of 2022 graduates who earned at least one IB exam score of 4 or higher was 6.5%, a decrease of 1.3 percentage points from 2020 but the same rate as 2021 graduates.
- In 2022, the share of graduates who took at least one IB exam ranged from 15.8 to 32.8% among IB schools. The percentage of 2022 graduates who earned at least one IB score of 4 or higher varied from 14.3 to 29.8% across all schools offering the IB programs. From 2020 to 2022, only Albert Einstein high school demonstrated an increase in IB exam participation (4.1 percentage-point increase) and performance (6.7 percentage-point increase) for all students.
- AP and IB exams are indicators of students' readiness for college-level coursework, and colleges use exam scores for possible course credit and placement of students in non-introductory courses. One way to gauge students' college readiness is by an AP exam score of 3 or higher or an IB exam score of 4 or higher. The AP/IB participation rate for MCPS graduates decreased from 68.0% in 2020 to 67.4% in 2021, and further declined to 64.2% in 2022. The percentage of 2022 graduates who scored a college-ready score in at least one AP/IB exam was 50.3%, a decline of 4.5 percentage points from 2020 and 4.4 percentage points from 2021.
