SUBJECT: ***Class of 2024 Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate Exam Participation and Performance***

Summary

- This memorandum provides information pertinent to the participation and performance of Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) examinations for 2024 graduates in Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS). In 2024, 61.8% of MCPS graduates took one or more AP exams, 18.4% more than graduates in Maryland and 26.1% more than graduates in the nation. Additionally, 46.5% of 2024 MCPS graduates earned a score of 3 or higher on at least one AP exam, while 27.8% of graduates in the State of Maryland and 22.6% of graduates in the nation earned an AP score of 3 or higher.
- From 2022 to 2024, ten out of 25 high schools saw increased AP exam participation rates for graduates identified as Black or African American, and 15 out of 25 high schools saw increases for graduates identified as Hispanic/Latino. Eight out of 25 high schools demonstrated an increase in AP exam participation for graduates who identified as Black or African American and Hispanic/Latino. Across high schools, 13 out of 25 high schools had increases in AP exam performance for graduates identified as Black or African American, and 12 out of 25 high schools showed improved AP exam performance rates for graduates identified as Hispanic/Latino. Eight out of 25 high schools saw an increase in AP exam performance rates for graduates who identified as Black or African American and Hispanic/Latino. Overall, Winston Churchill, Gaithersburg, Paint Branch, and Walt Whitman High Schools demonstrated increases in both AP exam participation and performance for graduates identified as Black or African American and Hispanic/Latino.
- Districtwide, the IB exam participation rate for all 2024 graduates was 11.3%, representing an increase of 3.9% compared to 2022. In 2024, 7.0% of all graduates earned a score of 4 or higher on at least one IB exam, representing a slight increase of 0.5% from 2022.
- In 2024, the proportion of graduates who took at least one IB exam ranged from 18.0% to 55.5% among schools offering IB programs. The percentage of graduates in 2024 who earned a score of 4 or higher on at least one IB exam ranged from 13.6% to 37.8% among schools offering IB programs. From 2022 to 2024, Rockville, Seneca Valley, and Springbrook High Schools demonstrated a steady increase in both IB exam participation and performance for all students.
- AP and IB exams are indicators of student readiness for college-level coursework, and colleges use exam scores for possible course credit and placement of students in non-introductory courses. One way to gauge a student's college readiness is by an AP exam score of 3 or higher or an IB exam score of 4 or higher. The overall AP and IB exam participation rate for MCPS graduates showed minimal growth, increasing from 64.2% in 2022 to 64.7% in 2024. The percentage of 2024 graduates who scored college-ready on at least one AP/IB exam was 49.2%, a decline of 1.1 percentage points from 2022.
