Sequence of Events:

I. <u>Journal Activity (15)</u> Prompt:

How do you feel about the process of creating your film so far?

II. <u>Genre (20)</u>

- 1. Ask students the genre of *IT HAPPENED ONE NIGHT*. (romantic comedy)
- 2. Have students list audience expectations for romantic comedy films. (1. Two romantic leads resist being a couple, but are together by the end of the film. 2. Both characters experience a character arc. 3. Humorous complications and misunderstandings keep the movie light and fun.)
- 3. List students' expectations for a horror film.
 (1. Exaggerated villain. 2. Chase scenes. 3. Danger lurking at every turn.
 4. The hero escapes harrowing obstacles in smart ways.)
- 4. Tell students that the next film they will be viewing is a horror film made just one year later in 1934 and called *THE BRIDE OF FRANKENSTEIN*.

III. The Bride of Frankenstein (150)

1. Students should retrieve LCL! 3x3 Story Paths from folders.

HANDOUT: LCL! 3x3 Story Path (in students' folder)

2. Watch *THE BRIDE OF FRANKENSTEIN*, stopping the film at the end of each of the LCL! 3x3 Story Path steps for a short discussion. Summarize each step as a class. Students write these summaries on their three shell sheets.

V. <u>Reflection</u> (15)

1. Direct students to the hanging chart paper labeled:

What step of the LCL! 3x3 Story Path, if any, would you have lengthened if you had been the filmmaker of *THE BRIDE OF FRANKENSTEIN*?

- 2. Hand out Post-its on which students write and post.
- 3. Review the comments on the Post-Its with the class, so students have a sense of what was learned that day. Make sure to clear up any misconceptions.
