Lights, Camera, FILM Literacy! Lesson Plan #27

Topics:

Journal Writing Creating a Documentary Film

Outcomes:

Students will follow organizational procedures.

Students will see and hear applicable vocabulary.

Students will work on the production of their documentary film.

Materials:

Writing journals

Camcorders

Tripods

Computers

Post-it notes

Handouts: Creating a Documentary Film (in students' folders)

Shot List

New Vocabulary: (no new words)

Sequence of Events:

I. Journal Activity (15)

Prompt:

How do you feel about making a documentary film?

II. Status and Clarification (15)

1. As a class, have each group report which step on the planning sheet they are currently working on.

HANDOUT: Creating a Documentary Film (in student folders)

- 2. Clarify questions about the planning sheet.
- 3. Tell students they are under a time crunch (the same as most professional filmmakers) and must complete a quality film as soon as possible.
- 4. Remind students that they must secure the teacher initials when they complete a step on the planning sheet.

III. Documentary Pre-Production and Filming (155)

- 1. Groups work on their documentaries with close supervision.
- 2. Make sure groups stay on task and encourage them as they moving through the process.

IV. Reflection (15)

1. Direct students to the hanging chart paper labeled:

What did you learn about planning a documentary film?

- 2. Hand out Post-its on which students write and post.
- 3. Review the comments on the Post-Its with the class, so students have a sense of what was learned that day. Make sure to clear up any misconceptions.

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
