# Lights, Camera, FILM Literacy! Lesson Plan #29

#### Topics:

## Journal Writing Creating a Documentary Film

#### Outcomes:

Students will follow organizational procedures. Students will see and hear applicable vocabulary. . Students will work on the production of their documentary film.

### Materials:

Writing journals Post-it notes Camcorders Tripods Computers

Handouts: Creating a Documentary Film (in students' folders) Shot List (in students' folders)

New Vocabulary: (no new words)

# Sequence of Events:

I. Journal Activity (15)

Prompt:

# What are some of the biggest challenges in creating your documentary film?

# II. <u>Producing a Documentary (155)</u>

1. Each group reports their current step on the planning sheet.

HANDOUT: Creating a Documentary Film (in student folders)

2. Groups continue working through the process of creating their documentaries.

# III. <u>Reflection (15)</u>

1. Direct students to the hanging chart paper labeled:

What did you learn about your planning script changing through the process of creating a documentary film.

- 2. Hand out Post-its on which students write and post.
- 3. Review the comments on the Post-Its with the class, so students have a sense of what was learned that day. Make sure to clear up any misconceptions.

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
