Lights, Camera, Literacy! High School Edition Lesson Plan #20

Topics: Journal Writing Export of Final Films The Film Festival

Outcomes:

Students will follow organizational procedures. Students will see, hear, and use applicable vocabulary. Students will export their final films. Students will celebrate their accomplishments.

Materials:

Journals LCD projector or Promethean Board Flash drives (one for each student) Computers with Editing Software Chart paper and Post-its or Promethean Board Pixar Short Films Collection Vol. 1 & 2

HANDOUTS: no handouts

New Vocabulary: No new Vocabulary

Sequence of Events:

I. Journal Writing (15)

Prompt: How do you feel about your completed film?

II. Export Final Films (45)

1. Instruct students to export their completed films as either .mov's or .mp4's.

III. Save Films to Student Flash Drives (60)

- 1. Give each student a flash drive to save their film and any other semester work they would like to keep. Allow students time to collect their films on their flash drives.
- 2. While students collect their films on their flash drives you can play the Pixar Short Films Collection DVD for students who finish early.

IV. <u>Film Festival</u> (75)

- 1. Welcome guests to the film festival and ask that cell phones be muted.
- 2. Each group, in turn, introduces their work, shows it, and responds to an audience Q & A.
- 3. Enjoy available refreshments and informal mingling.

V. <u>Reflection:</u> (15)

- 1. Students write their "Final Thoughts Before Saying Farewell" on the labeled chart paper.
- 2. Each student takes home their flash drives with all their completed films from the semester.
