## Sequence of Events:

I. <u>Journal Activity (15)</u> Today's Prompt:

## What is your reaction to the collaborative process of filmmaking?

- II. Exporting a scene to create a DVD. (30)
  - 1. Demonstrate how to export finished video and other features for creating a **DVD**.
  - 2. Groups view template choices and other options for creating a DVD.

III. <u>Production Time (140)</u>

- 1. Students plan, rehearse, shoot, edit, etc. to finish their productions for the film festival.
- 2. Teacher assists, as needed.
- IV. <u>Reflection (15)</u>
  - 1. Direct students to the hanging chart paper labeled:

- 2. Hand out Post-its on which students write an item to post on the chart.
- 3. Teacher wrap-up to review and clear up any misconceptions.
