## Lights, Camera, Literacy! (Part Two) Lesson Plan # 38

## Topics: Journal Writing Production Process DVD production Film Festival Preparation

#### Outcomes:

Students will follow organizational procedures. Students will see, hear, and use applicable vocabulary.

Students will complete their productions.

Students will complete tasks on the film festival preparation sheet.

#### Materials:

Writing journals Video cameras Tripods Mini-dv tapes or memory cards Computers with editing software LCD projector Chart paper Post-its Individual student pocket folders

HANDOUTS: Film Festival Planning Sheet (from last session)

New Vocabulary: (no new vocabulary)

#### Sequence of Events:

- I. Journal Writing (15)
  - 1. Today's Prompt:

## How do you feel about your collaboration skills as you prepare for the film festival?

# II. Film Festival Preparation (20)

- 1. Ask each group which of the film festival planning sheet items they have completed.
- 2. Remind students that even though the festival is on the last day of class, their deadline is the end of tomorrow's session as there will be a "dress rehearsal" for the film festival.
- 3. Further explain the items on the checklist, so that students may better work independently in completing each task.

# III. Production (150)

- 1. Students work on completing their productions.
- 2. Once completed, students create DVD's.
- 3. Students complete other tasks on the festival preparation sheet.

# IV. <u>Reflection: (15)</u>

1. Direct students to the hanging chart paper labeled:

# What are the greatest challenges your group is facing as you prepare for the film festival?

- 2. Hand out Post-its on which students write their response to post on the chart.
- 3. Review the comments on the Post-Its with the class, so students have a sense of what was learned. Make sure to clear up any misconceptions.
