  - The first and second front pages that you choose must be at least 70 years apart.
  - The second and third front pages that you choose must be at least 70 years apart.
  
- 2) In your visual report, explain how the following features change over the years:
  - Font size and variation
  - Photographs and captions
  - Number of columns
  - European news
  - Slogan and weather boxes
  - Indexes and content "helpers"
  - Cost of the newspaper
  - Entire articles vs parts of articles
  - Number of articles
  - Length of articles
  - Placement of headlines
  
- 3) Begin and end your visual report with statements that reflect your group's opinion as to your favorite of the three front page layouts and why.
