Topics:

Journal Writing Preparing for the LCML! Festival The Culminating Project

Outcomes:

Students will follow organizational procedures.

Students will see, hear, and use applicable vocabulary.

Students will review the preparation list for the LCML! Festival.

Students will work on their LCML! culminating project and indicate their progress.

Materials:

Writing journals

LCD projector

Chart paper

Post-its

Individual student pocket folders

Computers

Camcorders

HANDOUTS: Preparing For The LCML! Festival

LCML! Culminating Project Guide (from last session))

New Vocabulary: no new vocabulary

Sequence of Events:

I. Journal Writing (15)

1. Prompt:

What are your feelings about the upcoming LCML! festival?

II. Preparing for the LCML! Festival (20)

1. Review with students the list of preparations that need to happen by the festival day.

HANDOUT: Preparing For The LCML! Festival

2. Make sure students understand that their team's culminating projects must be done first. Then the team can check with you to determine which of the festival items still need to be completed.

III. LCML! Culminating Project (150)

1. Allow time for students to work on their projects.

IV. Reflection (15)

1. Direct students to the hanging chart paper labeled:

What have you learned by creating your culminating project?

- 2. Hand out Post-its on which students write and post.
- 3. Review the comments on the Post-Its with the class, so students have a sense of what was learned. Make sure to clear up any misconceptions.
