Lesson Plan # 39

Topics:

**Journal Writing
The Culminating Project
Preparing for the LCML! Festival**

Outcomes:

Students will follow organizational procedures.
Students will see, hear, and use applicable vocabulary.
Students will work on their LCML! culminating project and indicate their progress.
Students will prepare for the LCML! Festival.

Materials:

Writing journals
LCD projector
Chart paper
Post-its
Individual student pocket folders
Computers
Camcorders

HANDOUTS: *Preparing for the LCML! Festival* (from last session)
LCML! Culminating Project Guide (from last session.)

New Vocabulary: *no new vocabulary*

Sequence of Events:

I. Journal Writing (15)

1. Prompt:

What are your feelings about your culminating project?

II. Preparing for the LCML! Festival (20)

1. Review with students what still needs to be done on the list of festival preparations.

HANDOUT: PREPARING FOR THE LCML! FESTIVAL

2. Review the festival day procedures.

III. LCML! Culminating Project (150)

1. Each group reports their progress to the class.

2. Allow time for students to work on their projects.

IV. Reflection (15)

1. Direct students to the hanging chart paper labeled:

What else have you learned while working on your culminating project?

2. Hand out Post-its on which students write and post.

3. Review the comments on the Post-Its with the class, so students have a sense of what was learned. Make sure to clear up any misconceptions.
